Educational Theme	<p>Weather and Seasons: In the upcoming weeks, students will embark on an exciting exploration of "Weather & Seasons." They'll discover various weather conditions—like sunny, rainy, snowy, and windy—and learn how these vary with the seasons. Students will also explore the unique traits of each season—spring, summer, autumn, and winter—and find out what clothing and gear are best for staying comfortable in different weather. Through hands-on activities and discussions, they'll explore how weather affects daily life and how to adapt to changing conditions.</p>
